Systems Architecture

Alan Rosenhauer - Chief Technology Officer, Institute for Intergovernmental Research

Our March program is about how to develop and implement better IT systems for your customers. Our speaker is an acknowledged expert in the field of IT architecture. He is Alan Rosenhauer who is the Chief Technology Officer and Chief Technology Architect & Architecture Group Manager for the Institute for Intergovernmental Research. Alan has over twenty years experience in information systems.

Alan has been with the Institute for Intergovernmental Research (IIR) for eleven years and previously had his own consulting company, TN Systems, LLC in Franklin, TN for eight years. He started his IT career as a Senior Consultant with the Everest Consulting organization here in Nashville.

Alan will discuss the various development methods for systems architecture and the pros and cons for these methods. He will give us real world examples. Alan has transitioned the IIR systems development life cycle (SDLC) from waterfall to Agile, implemented Continuous Delivery, and switched to DevOps model thereby improving software delivery, reducing backlog, and increasing releases threefold. He also reduced office automation costs by moving services to the cloud.
