Artificial Intelligence

Melissa J. Harris - CEO, Telecom Training Corporation & Contract Trainers Corporation

Artificial Intelligence (AI) is a subject that many IT people have heard about but are not sure what it means to computer professionals. Our October speaker will discuss the status of AI applications, their success and their failure. She will also address such questions as to how to control AI. When AI computers generate their own programs, where will it end? There are few AI experts. Although not an "expert," our October speaker has been interested in AI for several years and has intensively studied the field. She has become quite knowledgeable in AI.
