## The Top Three Risks of Moving to the Cloud - and How to Avoid Them Rodney Hampton - Solutions Architect, Optiv

To kick off 2019 we have a great talk lined up. Everybody wants to get into, onto, and embrace the cloud.

Cloud adoption continues to accelerate with Forbes magazine predicting that 83% of enterprise 'workloads' will be in the cloud by 2020. What are the top three risks of moving to the cloud? Insufficient policy guidance and planning when migrating IT services to the cloud causes both confusion and missed opportunities. Not identifying threat actors and threat models applicable to how your organization delivers IT services via the cloud leads to investments in the wrong security solutions. Treating the cloud as an IT problem instead of a strategic business initiative results in lagging performance. If you want to both mitigate these risks and also unlock tomorrow, this talk is for you.
